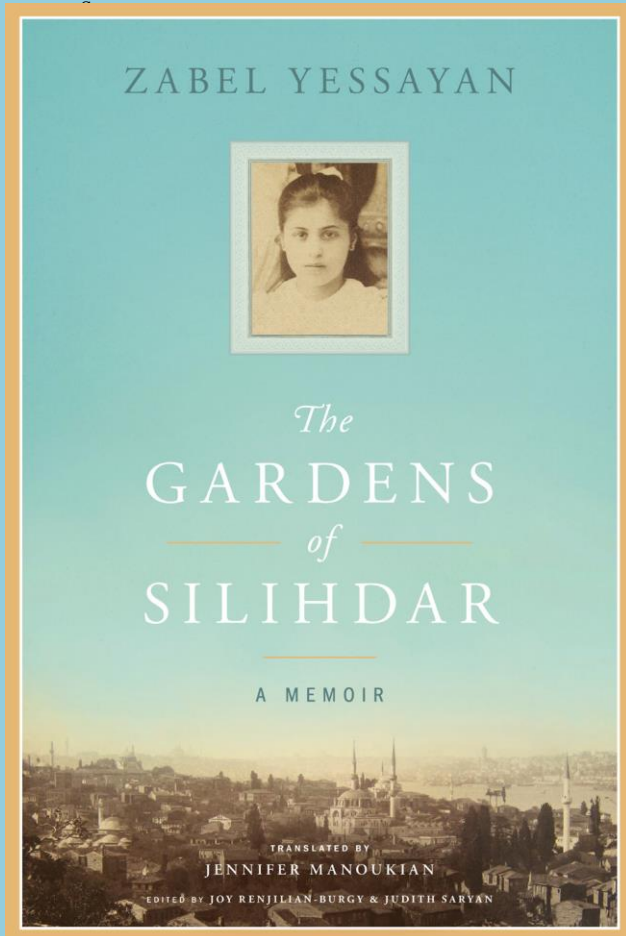


The Gardens of Silihdar

Author, educator and social activist Zabel Yessayan (1878-1943) is recognized as one of the greatest writers in Western Armenian literature. Her poignant 1935 autobiography displays the fierce determination of an Ottoman era Armenian intellectual who refused to accept the restrictions placed on women in Ottoman Turkey, and affords a vivid account of Armenian community life in Constantinople at the end of the 19th century.

Jennifer Manoukian is an accomplished translator, essayist and authority on the writings of Zabel Yessayan. She is a graduate student in Middle Eastern Studies at Columbia University.
